Father charged in infant death

MOORHEAD — A Moorhead man has pleaded not guilty in the death of his infant daughter who was left in a hot minivan for several hours last month.

Twenty-four-year-old Andrew Sandstrom pleaded not guilty Thursday to second-degree manslaughter.

Sandstrom's attorney entered the plea for the

father during a hearing. The Forum reports Sandstrom was present, along with his wife, but he didn't speak.

Police say 5-month-old Christiana Sandstrom died after she was left in her car seat in the van for about four hours on June 11. Temperatures were reported to be about 80 degrees.

Police say Sandstrom forgot about the infant while unloading five other young children out of the vehicle.

Unemployment continues to inch down

ST. PAUL — Minnesota's unemployment rate continued its downward trend in June, inching a tenth of a per-

cent lower than May.

The Department of Employment and Economic Development announced Thursday that the state's jobless rate for June was 5.2 percent, down from 5.3 percent a month earlier. Minnesota employers added 400 jobs in June, thanks to a 2,500-job increase in the private sector. That was offset by a 2,100-job loss in government employment.

n't from flames but from water, which is to be expected, Hovland said.

"We were able to pull a few items out of the main floor," Hovland said. "So they didn't lose everything."

Twenty-eight Fergus Falls firefighters responded to the scene, along with Elizabeth and Underwood fire departments, Fergus Falls Police and Ringdahl Ambulance.

Firefighters were on the scene until about 8 p.m. It took that long just to chop through the roof and pull down ceilings inside the house, Hovland said.

"There were a lot of hot spots," Hovland said. "It was a long night. Plus, the

arrested for pending charges including felony fourth-degree assault on a police officer, disorderly conduct and obstructing the legal process.

Each country has different kinds of duties and tariffs to pay," Hendrickson said "It's not as easy as shipping to Iowa, but a good healthy market is a good healthy market. We don't mind jumping through the hoops."

After establishing a strong market in the Midwest, Go-Float shipments have stretched across the country and into Canada.

Steady business from international markets help to keep steady production going at home, however.

"Like most water sport businesses, we had a bad spring. Demand has been up and down, but for the most part has really come back strong when the weather turned nice," Hendrickson said. "But international demand tends to level out the curves in our demand."

Go-Float boats are sold at 35 dealer locations across

the country, including Frontier Marine & Powersports in Fergus Falls. The Fergus Falls facility employs eight workers and another facility is based in the Twin Cities.

The company has become an innovative part of the Fergus Falls business community.

For Harold Stanislawski, executive director for the Economic Improvement Commission, the manufacturer has become an ambassador for the community.

"For a Fergus Falls manufacturer to be in an international market says a lot about the company and puts Fergus Falls on the map," he said.

"This shipment is great. It's going to a very different type of market in a different type of the world. Who knows what can happen when certain people see the manufacturing that is going on here," he added.
