### BOYS' HOCKEY: Jaguars advance in overtime

Bloomington Jefferson senior Joe Faust scored 2 minutes into overtime, giving the No. 9 Jaguars a wild 4-3 semifinal victory over No. 7 Burnsville on Saturday afternoon at Braemar Arena in Edina. "I had a good angle," Faust said. "This is what we've been focusing on."

It was the Jaguars' first victory over Burnsville this season and broke the Blaze' 11-game winning streak. They lost 3-1 a week ago and played to a 2-2 tie in January.

"We never had any doubt we were going to win," Jefferson assistant coach Denny Connelly said. "We felt we were in control of the game from the start."

Despite putting on the pressure early and often, Jefferson trailed for most of the game, until senior Caleb Herbert tied it at 3-3 on a power play in the

third period.

In the other semifinal, Ryan Cutshall scored 5:37 into the third period, giving No. 5 Edina a 3-2 victory over Holy Angels.
