Upon their return, Korey worked at GNC before taking a job as a sports coordinator and member engagement coordinator at the YMCA. From there he worked at Lakes Country

Academy first as a teaching assistant and then a special education teacher. The school serves at-risk students, and Korey helps prepare them to transition back to general-population schools.

Mary worked in nursing at PioneerCare, Lake Region Healthcare and in-home care. Most recently, she's the director of nursing at PioneerCare.

Wanting to give back and serve the community, Korey is also a member of the Fergus Falls Fire Department. "I always looked up to firemen, just because I knew a few in the neighborhood where I grew up," Korey said.
