Oct. 4, trying to beat ol' man winter in getting the building insulated. The bulk of the work was the clean up of the building and debris removal.

"The clean out was massive," Habraken said. "Everything that's been touched by water has been torn out. The roof was the next big thing."

The building was heavily damaged by water and then the weather's elements; it wasn't protected since the roof burned during the fire. They have a new roof in place, going with a pitched-roof design, which is a better option than the previous flat roof, according to Habraken.

The next step is installing windows and replacing siding on the back of the building.

"As soon as the windows

are in, then our job is to just make it inhabitable again," Habraken said. "We'll build it to suit anybody. We'd prefer to find a business that complements the retail environment."

By the time it's all said and done, the project will have cost nearly \$300,000, Habraken said. They're hoping to be done three months from now, but "any little thing can make that six months, too," he said.

Official: Too soon to link pond's location, deaths

ST. PAUL — The pond in St. Louis Park where two children died when a car veered off a highway ramp is one of hundreds of retention basins near roadways in the Twin Cities, and the state patrol says it's too soon to say whether the pond's location had a role in the crash.

Three other children survived when Marion Guerrero went off the roadway and dropped down an embankment into the pond. The car sank in 9 feet of water. Guerrero, 23, of Brooklyn Center, escaped. The three children remain hospitalized.

Minnesota State Patrol Lt. Eric Roeske told the St. Paul Pioneer Press that the agency's inquiry in the crash could take weeks or

months. Officials there then plan to release their findings to Hennepin County Attorney Mike Freeman for review.

Roeske said he has seen and heard people speculate about the role the retention basin played in the crash. Such talk is premature, he said, adding the agency needs "to determine the facts of the case before we make statements about what contributed or may have contributed to the incident."

"I know there's a lot of outcry about retention ponds and why there wasn't a guardrail," he said. "I've seen those statements, but we really need to wait and reserve judgment until the investigation is complete and deal with the factors that were truly involved."
